





## Doric Wines, White 2017

(Y)

Mountainous Roditis and Malagousia from high altitude vineyards in Fokida, Central Greece at 800 m altitude. Hand-harvested, destemmed, 7 days skin contact, natural winemaking, minimal SO<sub>2</sub> addition, (from 2018 vintage there is none added) 11.8% abv. Vivification follows the wine tradition of the area including fir branches on top of fermenting grapes. According to producer George Balatsouras whose total production is under 5000 bottles, this is applied for three reasons: 1. to keep the cap submerged 2. to add discrete aromas of resin 3. for further protection from oxidation

Scary deep amber coloured. Discrete aromas of oregano, white pepper, nutmeg around a core of glazed apricot. Clean and intense. The tannins are obvious on the palate but are very welcomed bringing extra brightness to the super fresh finish. Taste it without prejudice and you will be rewarded.
